The Qatar Health Congress 2026 will maintain, if not exceed, the standards of credibility and excellence built on the recent iterations of Qatar Health. Qatar Health Congress (QHC) 2026 will provide state-of-the-art updates from experts in the field of Internal Medicine, all of its sub-specialties (Endocrine/Diabetes, Rheumatology, Pulmonary, Gastroenterology, Nephrology, Infectious Disease, Allergy, and Immunology, as well as Trauma and Critical Care and Artificial Intelligence (AI). 
There will be ample opportunities for presentations of submitted abstracts. At conservative estimate is set at 30 to 50 abstract per track.


