
# Sepsis: Hit it early; Hit it Right

**PROBLEM**: Only 10% of patients admitted under MICU care are receiving the first dose of antibiotics within one hour of suspicion/diagnosis of sepsis.

**AIM**: To improve the compliance with antibiotic administration in septic patients admitted under MICU care within 1 hour of sepsis diagnosis, from 10% to 50% by May 2016 and 70% by December 2016.

#### **INTERVENTION:**

- 1. Education sessions to improve the awareness among staff members.
- 2. Cerner: sepsis bundle
- 3. Sepsis posters to raise awareness and early management



## TEAM:

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### **CONCLUSIONS:**

- Busy schedule of physician
- Delay recognition of sepsis
- Delay in preparation and administration of antibiotics
- 4. Lack of awareness regarding new sepsis definition and pathway

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

- Continuity of data collection- once per week
- Education of new staff including doctors and nurses.
- · Bimonthly run chart and data assessment
- Cerner troubleshooting
