

Say Sepsis: Do sepsis Six : Save Lives

PROBLEM : Lack of awareness of the sepsis six pathway and its implementation in sepsis patients admitted to AMAU in February 2016.

AIM: To improve early recognition of sepsis among patients admitted to AMAU and improve implementation of sepsis six pathway from 0%-50% from march 1st 2016 – May 14 2016 .

INTERVENTION:

- Educational Sessions to Physicians and nurses
- Visual Cues to Say sepsis at diagnosis and to apply sepsis six pathway (3 IN &3 OUT)
- Check List in the unit to confirm Sepsis and to apply Sepsis Six pathway

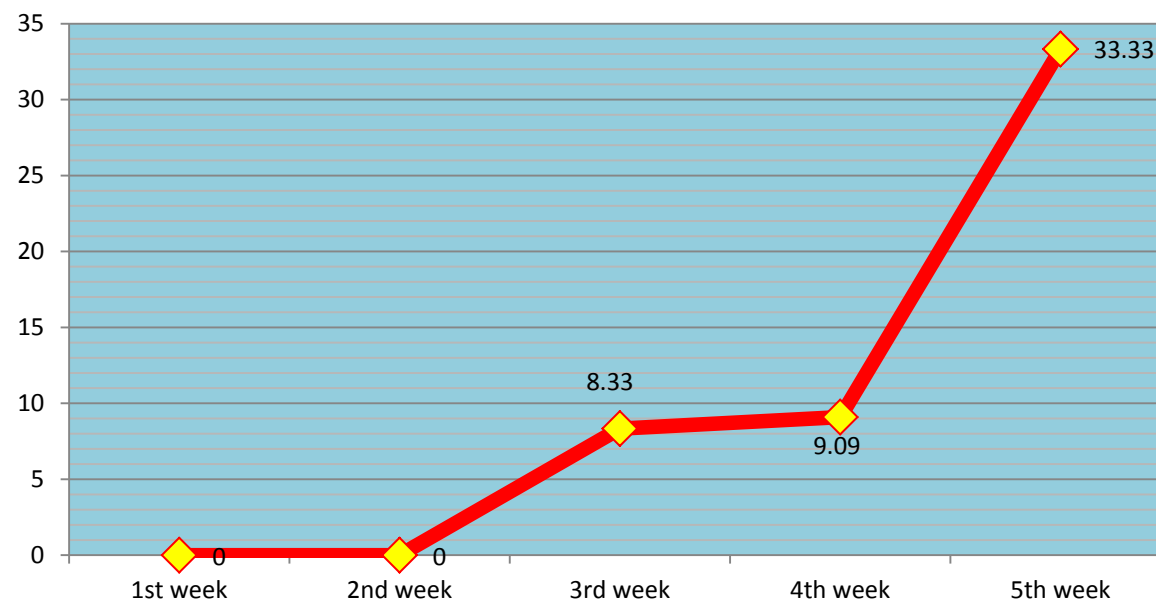

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RESULTS:

COMPLIANCE TO ALL COMPONENTS OF SEPSIS 6 IN %



CONCLUSIONS:

- Improvement in awareness of sepsis six pathway to 100% among physicians and nurses
- Improvement in urine out put monitoring by60% and blood culture prior to antibiotics by 50%
- Failure to achieve goal of 50% in implementing all components of sepsis six pathway but implementation improved from 0%-33%.

- Focus on Sepsis Six implementation in 6North 1 & 6North 3

- Continuing Sepsis Education: Physician
