

Improvement of Sepsis Awareness In Patients Attending West Bay H.C

PROBLEM: Currently all of our diabetic and elderly (>60 year old) patients attending NCD clinic at West Bay Health Center lack awareness about sepsis signs & symptoms in putting them at increased risk of morbidity and mortality from sepsis.

AIM: To improve awareness about sepsis signs & symptoms in diabetic and elderly (>60 year old) patients at NCD clinic at West Bay Health Center from 0% to 30% by 31st December 2015

INTERVENTION:

- Video which contains awareness about the most common symptoms and sign of sepsis .
- Using texting app as a way of communication with the patient to send the video (WhatsApp)
- Brochure that contains the most common symptoms and sign of sepsis.

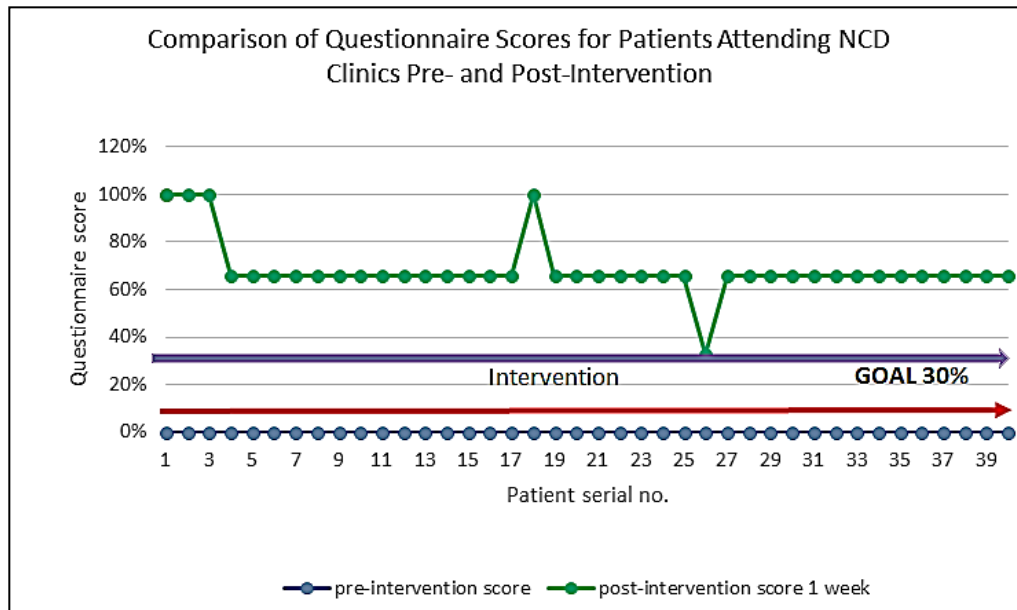
