INTERVENTION:

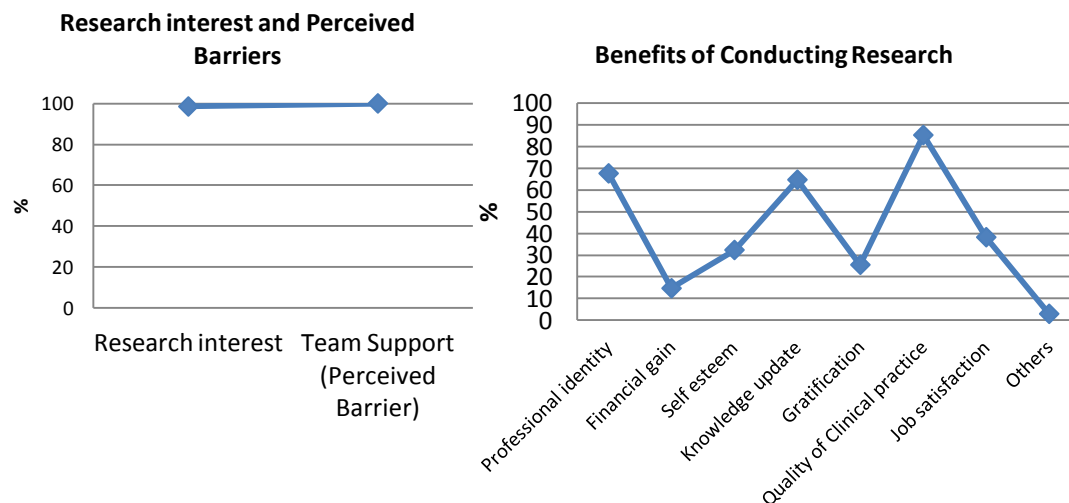
Electronic survey questionnaire circulated among all occupational therapist across HMC.
